PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Chavez directed the Pledge of Allegiance.

The special meeting of the Helper City Council was called to order by Mayor Chavez at 6:00.

AWARD BID FOR WATER, SEWER, AND STORM DRAIN PROJECT.

Chad Brown, Franson Engineering, announced the bids for Area 5 as follows: Silver Spur \$7,612,000, Vancon \$8,100,000, Condie \$8,347,000, and Whitaker \$8,700,000. Mr. Brown recommended the council to award the bid to Silver Spur Construction. Mr. Brown explained Silver Spur has a bonding capacity of \$8,000,000 so this will be their only project. Silver Spur will have their whole crew working on this project instead of subbing out many of the jobs. Silver Spur has worked on large projects before so the company should be able to handle the job.

Council Member Pugliese moved to award the bid for Area 5 to Silver Spur Construction. Council Member Harwood seconded the motion. Motion Carried: Pugliese, Llewelyn and Harwood voting yes.

DISCUSSION AND/OR APPROVAL ON WATER AND SEWER PROJECT ISSUES.

Chad Brown addressed the council on Terry Larsen Construction is asking for more time to complete Area 4. Terry Larsen right now owes the city \$63,000 in delay fees and the owner is claiming he did not know that the project was behind. Council Member Harwood told council he had contacted the City's insurance concerning Olive Richeda. The city insurance will pay Miss Richeda \$5,000 out of the no fault funds and then try to collect from Terry Larsen's insurance.

Council Member Llewelyn moved to pay Olive Richeda \$5,000 from the no fault insurance fund. Council Member Pugliese seconded the motion. Motion Carried: Pugliese, Llewelyn and Harwood voting yes.

There being no further business Council Member Pugliese moved to adjourn. Council Member Harwood seconded the motion. Motion Carried: Pugliese, Llewelyn and Harwood voting yes. Meeting adjourned.
