PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The regular meeting of the Helper City Council was called to order by Mayor Chavez at 6:00.

APPROVAL OF THE CORRECTED MINUTES February 6 and 18, 2014.

Council Member Bradley moved to approve the corrected minutes of February 6 and 18, 2014. Council Member Mascaro seconded the motion. Motion Carried. Bradley, Mascaro, Llewelyn and Harwood voting yes.

CRYSTAL YOUNG DISCUSSION ON RIVER RESTORATION PROJECT.

Ms Young was unable to attend the meeting and emailed information for the council to review. Council Member Bradley informed the council the information was basically the schedule for grant applications and the starting of the pilot project.

ARNIE COOPER DISCUSSION ON ATV TRAILS.

Mr. Cooper was unable to attend the meeting. This item will roll to the next agenda.

MIKE JAMES DISCUSSION ON OUTLAW CAR SHOW.

Mr. James was not able to attend the meeting, but asked if he could have everything the car show had last year.

Council Member Mascaro moved to allow the Outlaw Car Show to use the city park with free swimming. Council Member Harwood seconded the motion. Motion Carried. Bradley, Mascaro, Llewelyn and Harwood voting yes.

JEFF CISNEROS UPDATE ON AMERICAN LEGION BASEBALL.

Mr. Cisneros stated he would not be coaching the American Legion this year, but he will still be involved with the program. The first tournament will be held on June 19-22, regular games will begin the first week in July.

REPORT ON WATER, SEWER, AND STORM DRAIN PROJECTS.

Council Member Harwood reported Condie Construction will start on March 10 to finish up Area 1. Nielson Construction will start paving around March 24 depending on the weather. Silver Spur will be starting Area 5 on North Main by Workmen's Market on March 19.

MOTION FOR CLOSED SESSION.

REPORTS FROM COUNCIL MEMBERS AND HEADS OF DEPARTMENT.

Council Member Mascaro reported the downtown businesses would like to use the Main Street Park for 1st Saturdays with different events. The Museum is coming up on its 50th Anniversary so a celebration is being planned.

Council Member Bradley reported the pool plaster in the shallow end needs to be redone and will cost about \$20,000. Council Member Harwood will look into getting this done before the pool opens.

Mayor Chavez reported the water, sewer project has gone over budget by about 4 million dollars. Franson engineers will be looking for grant funding if possible.

There being no further business Council Member Mascaro moved to adjourn. Council Member Bradley seconded the motion. Motion Carried: Bradley, Mascaro, Llewelyn and Harwood voting yes. Meeting adjourned.
